aforesaid of eighty one <sup>80</sup> dollars current,  
be and the same are hereby  
accepted approved and  
ratified. - Carried

Moved by Councillor Grimes  
seconded by Councillor Langford  
that the secretary  
treasurer be and he is hereby  
authorized to pay eight dollars  
to each of the auditors for services  
by them performed auditing the  
books of the Secretary Treasurer,  
and that the secretary treasurer  
be and he is required to hand  
over and deliver the books of  
the Corporation including the  
valuation roll and collection  
rolls, to the ~~and~~ ~~that~~ council  
of the Corporation Peter Ayler by  
to the end that the said council  
may institute legal proceedings  
for the recovery of all arrears  
of taxes due to the corporation  
of Hull. - Carried

Moved by Councillor Wright seconded by Councillor Langford - That Robert Turley and Howard B. Prentiss be and they are hereby appointed auditors for the ensuing two years. - Carried.

On the seventh day of February 1870, Councillor Wright Langford and Grimes only being present, the regular session of the municipal council of Hull for the month of February 1870 was upon motion of councillor Wright seconded by councillor Langford adjourned to the eleventh day of February 1870.

At a general session of the municipal council of the townships of Hull held at Chateau on the eleventh day of February 1870 being an adjourned general session of the said municipal council from the seventh day of February 1870, of which due notice was given to each of the Municipal Councillors of the said townships of Hull, at which were present Councillor William Wright Michael Grimes Richard Langford and Thomas McGoy Mayor forming a quorum of the said municipal Council, the said Thomas McGoy presiding - Councillor Michael Grimes took the oath of office.

It was and is unanimously resolved and declared

Upon motion of Councillor Wright seconded by Councillor Grimes -

Whereas in the census count for the district of Hull, a certain mill

Council qualified to act for the said  
Corporation; and that Messrs Flaming  
Gluck & Kenney have never been consulted  
or retained, and have never been and are  
not employed by the Corporation of the  
Township of Hull or by any person body  
or municipal Council authorized to  
act for the said Corporation, as the  
attorneys of the said Corporation of the  
Township of Hull to prosecute the said suit  
or to take any proceedings in law whatever

on behalf or in the name of the said Corporation  
of the Township of Hull against the said  
Peter Leyton

And that the said Corporation  
of the Township of Hull did and doth  
humbly disown the said suit or action  
and all and each of the proceedings  
had and taken therein in the name and  
on behalf of the said Corporation  
by the aforesaid Messrs Flenny  
Church & Kenny, as the ~~attorneys~~ and  
did and doth humbly disown Messrs  
Flenny Church & Kenny as the attorneys  
of the said Corporation in the said suit.

And it was and is further  
unanimously resolved and declared

That Peter Leyton of the  
village of Leyton in the district of Ottawa  
Esq; Advocate, hath been and is  
humbly constituted and appointed the  
attorney of the Corporation of the Township  
of Hull with power, for and in the name  
of the Corporation of the Township of Hull  
to make a disavowal of the said suit or  
action and of all and each of the  
proceedings had taken therein by the  
aforesaid Messrs Flenny Church & Kenny,  
and of Messrs Flenny Church & Kenny as  
attorneys of the Corporation of the Township  
of Hull in the said suit or action, and  
with power to file and furnish reasons  
or grounds of disavowal to plead  
oppon ~~et~~ et d'omnile and generally to  
do, for and in the name and on behalf of

The corporation of the Township of Well in and about the said divisional whatever the code of procedure and the law requires, and he shall deem necessary and to the intent of the said corporation in the prosecution of the said divisional the same.
