of the Township of Mill in the County of York
held at the Town Hall (the proper
place known by the name of the
Hall held on the nineteenth
day of January nineteen
hundred and twenty at the hour
of twelve o'clock in the forenoon in con-
formity with the notices served by on all
the said Municipal Councillors by
Lionel Macpherson Esquire one of Her
Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and
for the said County of Ottawa acting
as president at the election which took
place on said Township of
the twenty day of the said month, the
names of the electors and as appears by the
returns hereto annexed.

Present Ezra B. Eddy, Richard
McConnell, Charles Graham, Samuel
Rank, Marie Bisson, Hercule
Grenier who being duly sworn
according to law proceeded as
follows.

Moved by Councillor Graham seconded by Councillor McCombe that Verie Titian of the said Village of Hulse Esquire Notary Public be Secretary Treasurer of the Council with a salary of one hundred dollars per year by giving sufficient sureties to the amount to be fixed by the Mayor. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Pink seconded by Councillor Graham that Hugh Wright and Esquire Trades and Miller McKay Wright Esquire Advocate both of the said Township of Hulse be appointed as sureties for the Secretary Treasurer. Carried.

Moved by Councillor McCombe seconded by Councillor Reason that the books and papers of the Council shall be demanded from John Aylen the previous Secretary Treasurer and that the present Secretary Treasurer Verie Titian and Councillor Graham be authorized to make such demand which shall be a Notarial one. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Graham seconded by Councillor Pink that the Secretary Treasurer do notify the Secretary and Presidents of the Gutierrez Macadamizing and Gravelled Road Companies of the Election of E. B. Edley as Mayor of this Municipality. Carried.
