Parking Ban for a snow accumulation of 5 to 10 cm or more	
A winter overnight parking ban advisory will be issued as soon as Environment Canada forecasts a snow accumulation of 5 to 10 cm or more for the Ottawa-Gatineau area.	
Subscribe for winter parking ban notices!	
It is possible to receive parking ban notices by text message or email. To do so, all you have to do is register with the notification system at gatineau.ca/avisstationnementhiver .	
Once registered, you will automatically receive, before 3:00p.m., an email or text message notifying you of the parking ban. When the parking ban is lifted, you will receive a second message informing you that you can park on the street again.	
Note that even if your street has been cleared of snow, you must wait for the announcement of the lifting of the parking ban before parking again on the street.	
* IMPORTANT:	
Despite the fact that you are registered with the parking ban notices by email or text messaging, it remains your responsibility to check with the City of Gatineau daily (by dialing 311 or by consulting the City of Gatineau website at gatineau.ca). The notices in effect are available no later than 3 p.m.	
<u>Concerning Telecommunications Service Provider</u>	
<i>Although Gatineau issues the advisories by text message (SMS) free or charge, your telecommunications service provider may bill you. Text messages (SMS) are compatible with most mobile devices.</i>	
GENERAL CONDITIONS	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At all times, when the vehicle is parked on the side of a public thoroughfare, this permit must be hung on your rear-view mirror so that it is legible from the outside for identification purposes; 2. The cost of the permit is non-refundable. In the event of loss or theft, you will have to pay the entire cost to obtain a new permit; 3. The general winter overnight parking permit is valid from December 1st to April 1st; 4. The permit holder may park his vehicle on the side of the public thoroughfare, making sure to follow the signs in place; 5. The citizen must provide a valid driver's license with a residence address in Gatineau or all other supporting documents stipulated in By-law 300-2006 for special cases (ex: student or contract worker); 6. The City of Gatineau may, during the calendar year, cancel the said permit or revise its tariff. In such event, the City will inform me of its decision with twenty (20) days notice; 7. The City of Gatineau assumes no responsibility for loss, damage, theft, accidents or other incidents to which the vehicle or its contents may suffer.
